

<Systems of entrance exam of universities>



- Documents of personal information and interview


The case of Thailand

TCAS (a system consisting of five types of exam)

	contents	cost
1	Documents of personal information	50 baht
2	Recommended admission examination	Decision of University
3	The same achievement test all at once	500~1100 baht
4	GPA, O-net, GAT/PAT are considered	150 ~300 baht
5	Each university's original exam	Decision of university
