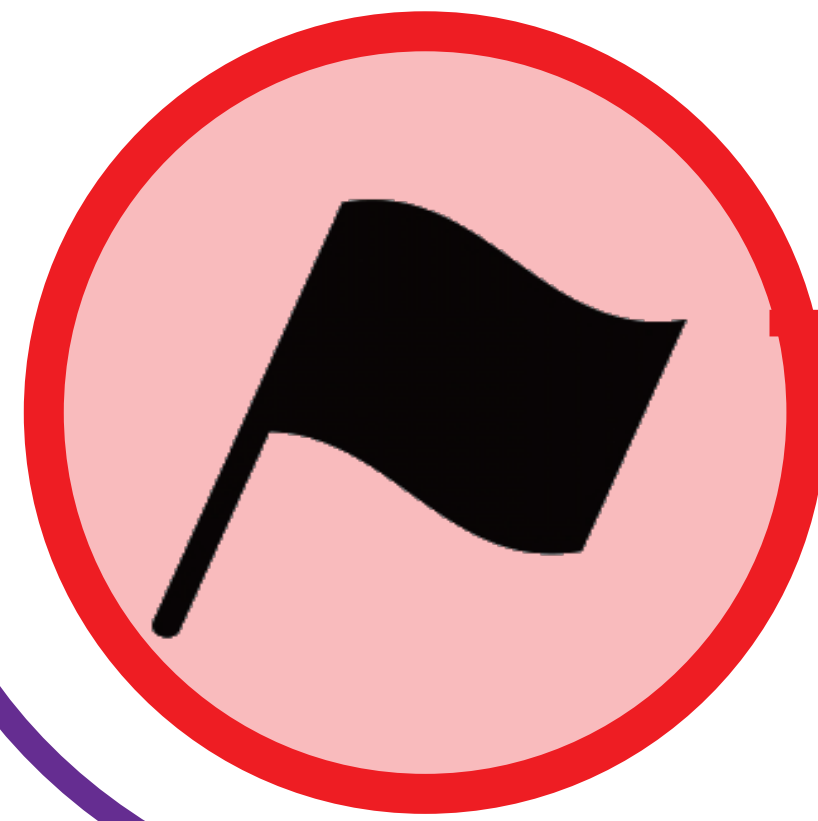

NATIONALISM

POSSIBLE SOLUTION: EDUCATING THE NECESSITY

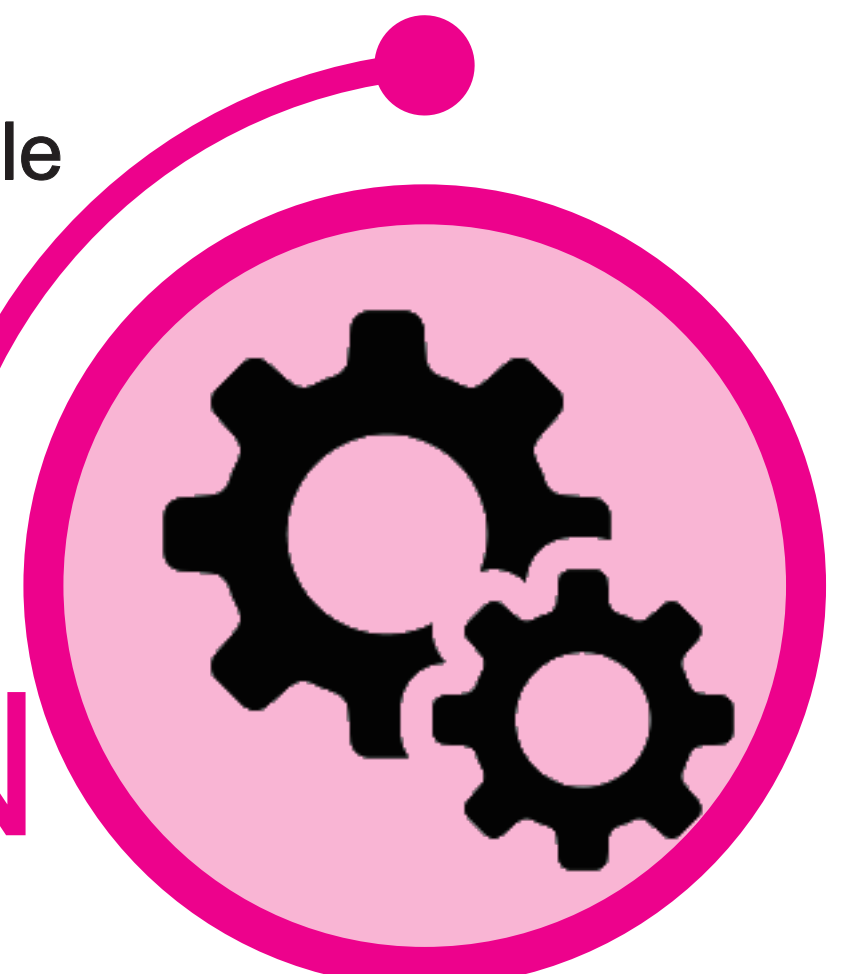


ANXIETY

The financial anxiety makes people want to define what exactly is causing them to suffer. In most cases, they only blame globalization. They glorify the past and demonize immigrants, often stirring up xenophobia. They lean toward nationalism and become less concerned about global issues, prioritizing short-term profit of their own country over all other nations.

Due to the movement of production bases, job opportunities for unskilled workers in developed countries have declined and made the poor even poorer. This brought up financial anxiety among people.

While more and more jobs are being automated, emerging technologies are not creating a sufficient number of new jobs to substitute for the old ones. Automation might be responsible for the current growth of unemployment and people' s anxiety for their future.
