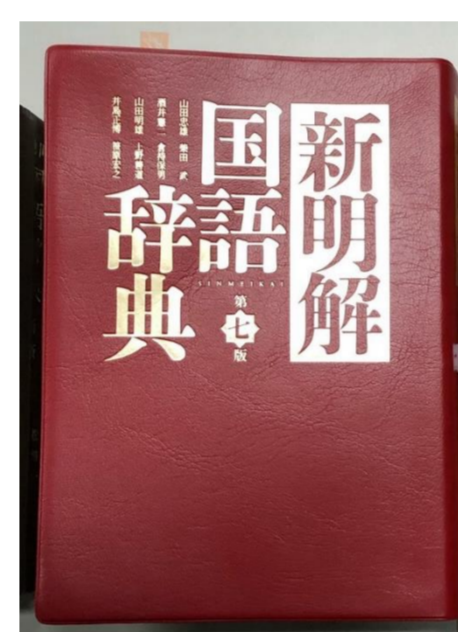
Purpose : To find out what "quality education" is

Method 1

Examining the Japanese language

-The criteria for the positive words-

- ① spare someone's feelings
- ② make someone feel happier
- ③ propel someone forward
- ④ become full of love

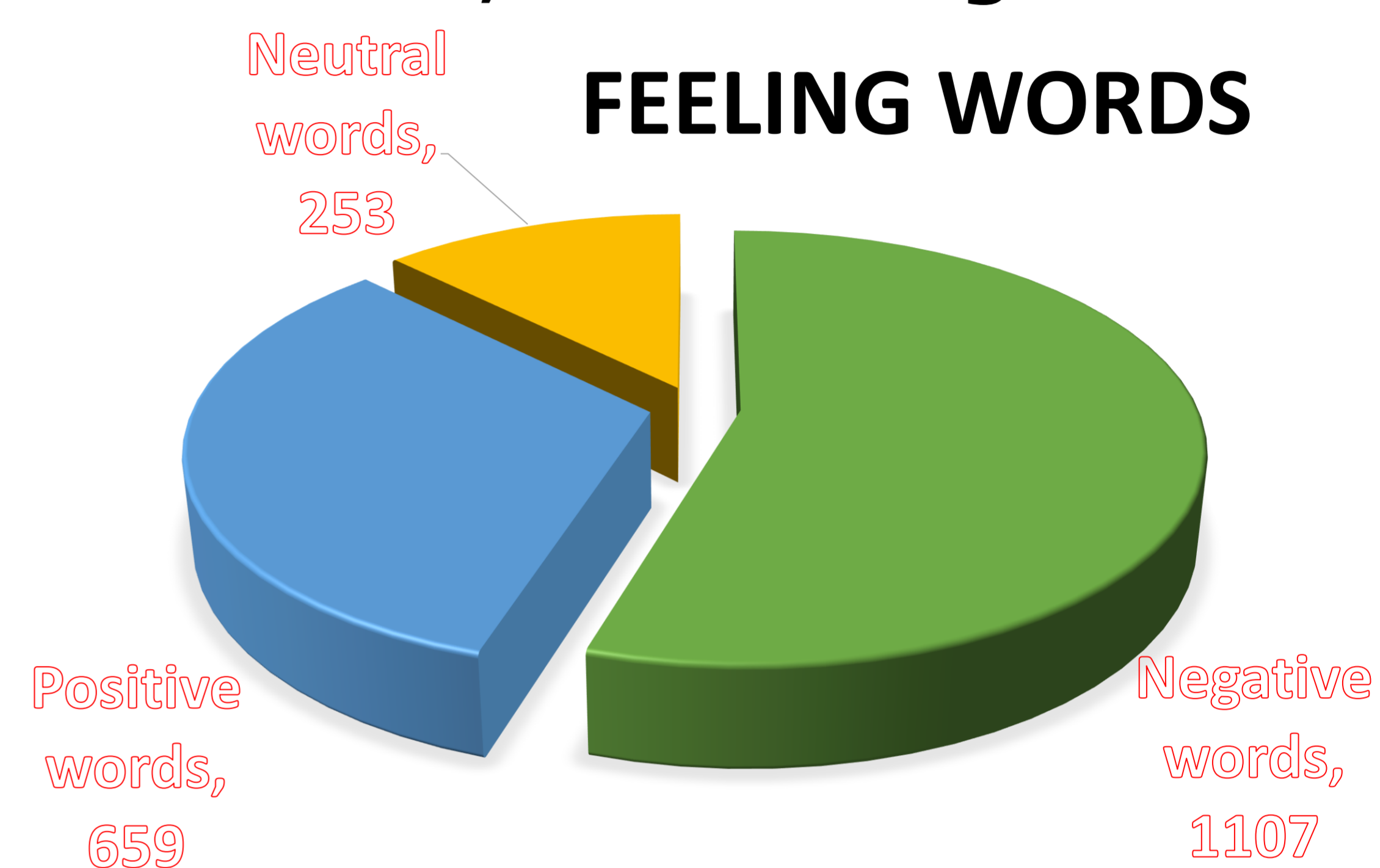


-The criterion for the negative words-

- ① lacerate someone

Result 1

We found 2,019 "feeling words."



Method 2

Identifying the usage frequency of the positive and negative words in the field of education

We interviewed 15 teachers at our school.

Result 2

Most teachers answered they scold more often than they praise.

They tend to use negative reinforcement.

The nature of human beings
negative bias, emotional inertia, psychological projection

There are so many negative factors. Our lives are inundated with these factors, which make us less aware of our strengths.

Method 3

Conducting workshops & interviews

To let the participants become aware of their subconscious strength



Result 3

The percentage of participants who felt happier than before by noticing their strengths in our workshops was about **97%**.
