- ② Shortage of medical professionals



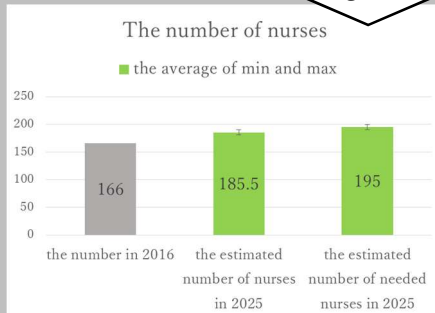

Latent Nurses (= The nurses who have licenses but don't work as a nurse.)

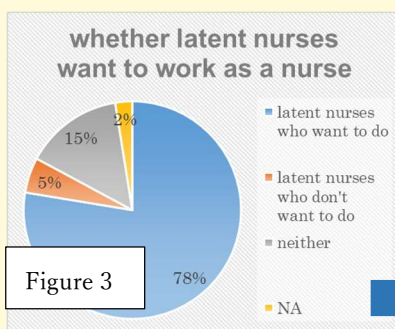

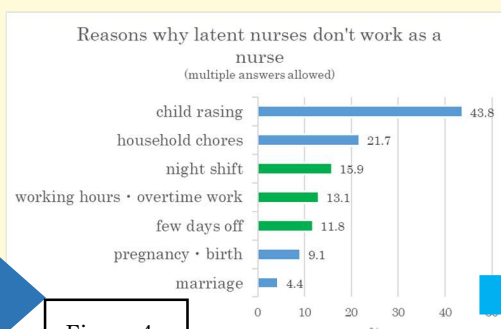
