in Akita City...

There are not enough special nursing homes

But elderly population is still **increasing** now


→ **“Wait-listed”**

2200 people are waiting for an opening (2020)



Building new nursing homes = **unsustainable**

Population change in Akita city (Age 65+)



1.0 = the number as of 2010

HOW DOES IT WORK?



Hospitals provide **medical care** for nursing homes

→ Can Accept more people



Re-use nursing homes
Example: Special nursing home

→ Will reduce cost



Cooperate between facilities

→ Can provide better care

PLUS,
Re-use closed schools to **reduce** cost.

In Akita City,

18 schools will be closed.


