







- Use these animals as gibier.




Plan

This graph shows the level of awareness of gibier cuisine by age group.

Surprisingly, older people know less about gibier than younger people.

• In other words, target young people and offer them gibier cuisine.

• For example, as school lunches in elementary and junior high schools.
