

- The teacher often don't have enough skills, education, training,or knowledge to teach the students efficiently.


Nigerien domestic environment

We made a video about the relationship between Child marriage and School education in Niger, also show the video to 400 students then took two survey to compare the changes of their thinking.


How much of the people have concern about child marriage.
