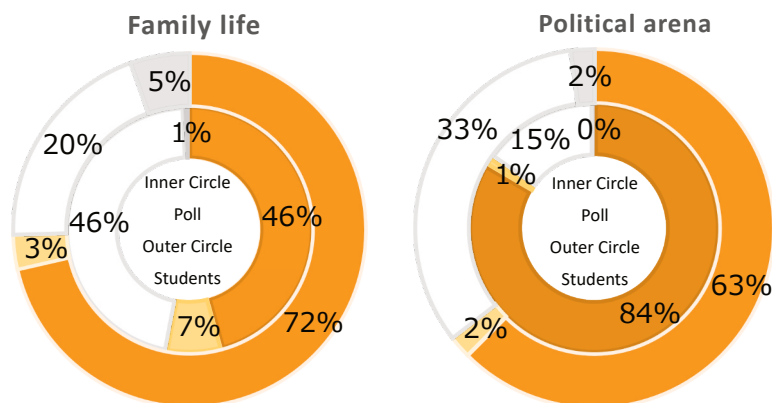
Poll Result and Discussion

Students: 389 people

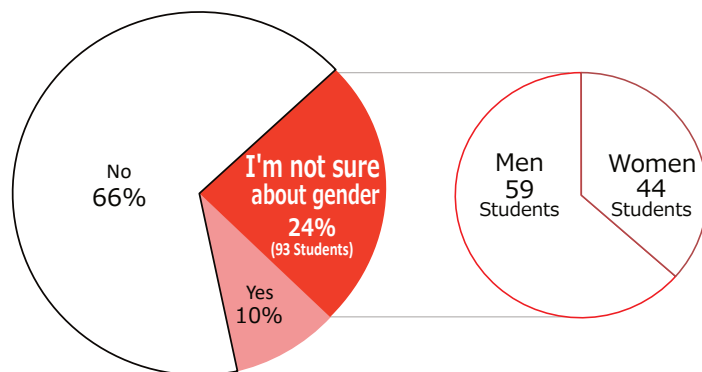
