

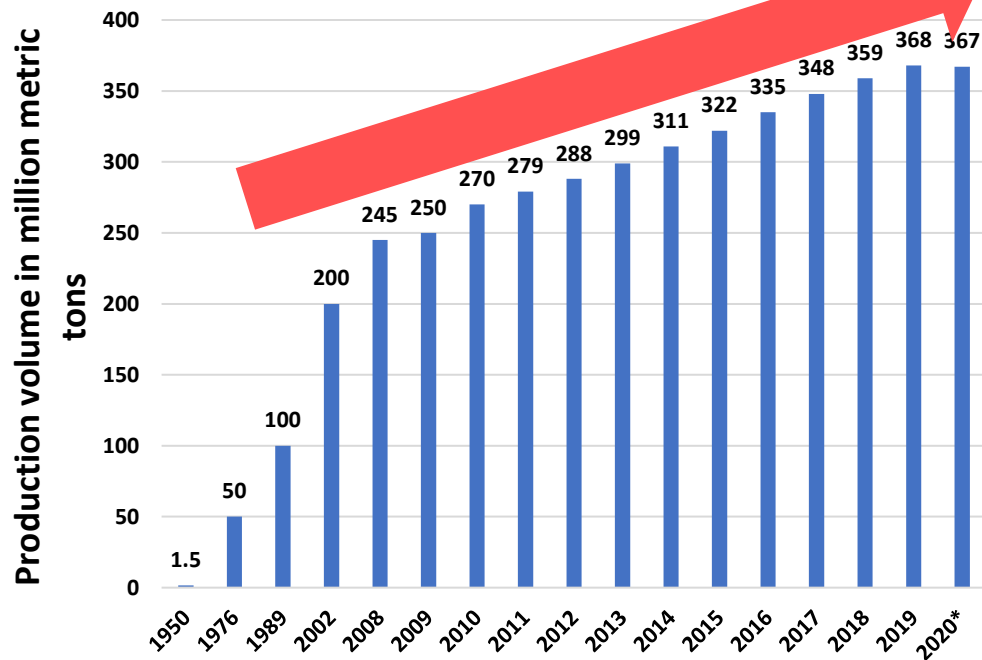

⇒ 80,000 tons of trash

22% (CSIRO)

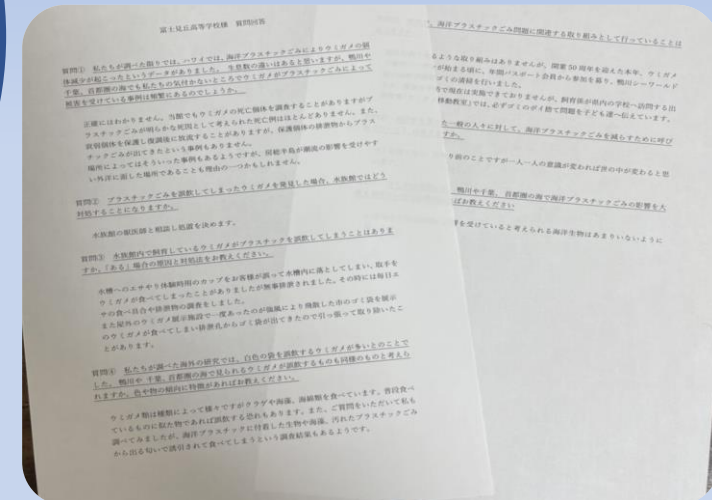

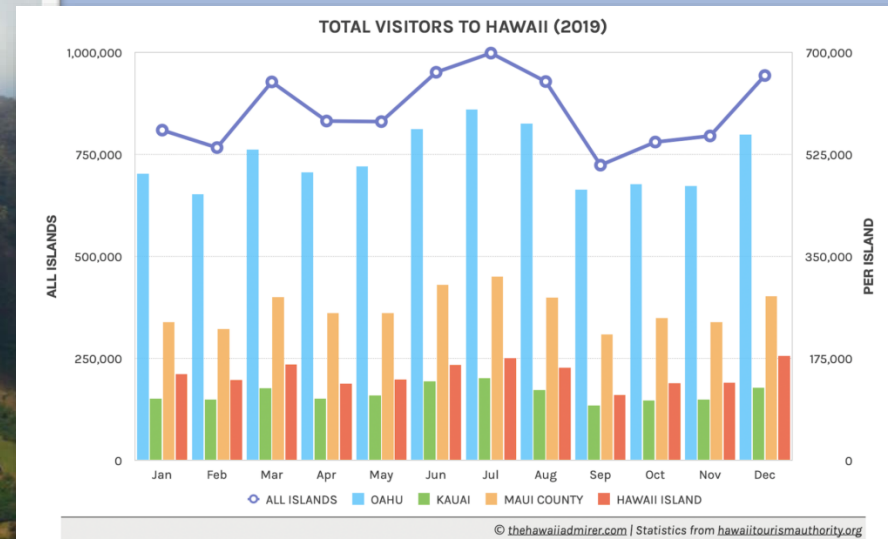

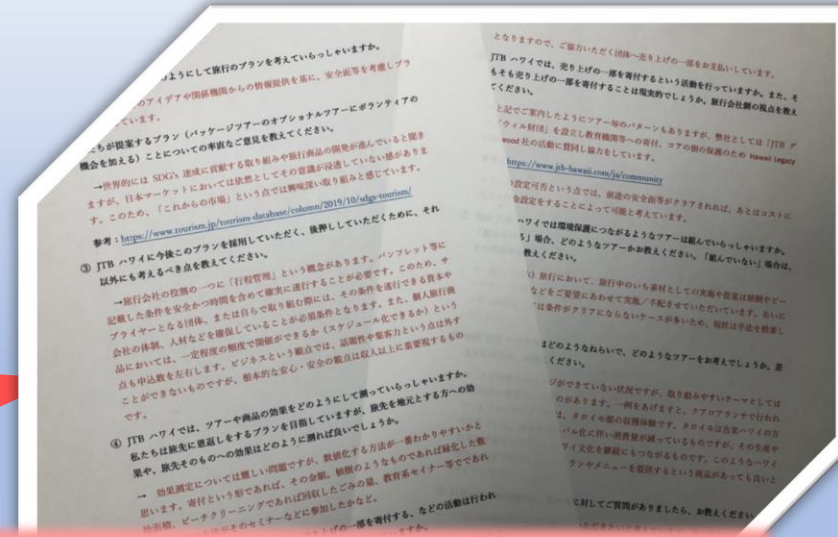
