4. How to Attend Zoom Meetings (Limited to Students Only)

I) Preparation Before the Day of the Event

- Pre-registration is required for this Zoom meeting. No one with other than the registered email address can participate.
- The URL required to join a Zoom meeting will be sent by Zoom <no-reply@zoom.us> to your registered email address when you complete filling out the Zoom meeting registration form. The invitation email to the Zoom meeting will be resent on Saturday, December 17. If you have not received the email from Zoom, you will not be able to participate in the Zoom meeting.
- Please use a device with a camera and a microphone on the day of the event.

2) How to Attend Zoom Meetings on the Day of the Event

- Attend Zoom meetings basically with your microphone muted and video off, and turn on your microphone
 and video when you speak or when instructed to do so by the moderator or others.
- When displaying your name on Zoom, put your "school name" in English. If your school name is too long
 to be fit on Zoon screen, use an abbreviated version as appropriate (e.g., Tsukuba Sakado).
- On the day of the event, students should join the Zoom meeting between 0:45 and 1:00pm JST. Please do
 not leave the meeting room until the end of "3. Discussion", which is scheduled to end at 4:45pm.
- Students participating in "2. Presentations" and "3. Discussion" should attend the Zoom meetings instead
 of watching the YouTube live video streaming.

5. Comments from Award-Winning Schools

Schools that won Minister of Education Award, Chief Judge's Award, Chief Judge's Special Award, and Students' Choice Award will be asked to make a brief comments in English in one minute.

NOTE: The award-winning schools were notified in advance last year, however, the award winners will be announced on the day of the event this year.
