



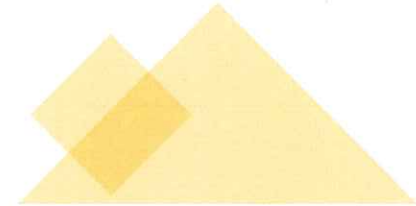

About Ikuno ward


- more than one in five of its 130,000 residents having foreign nationals
