3. Society thinks nursing is women's job.

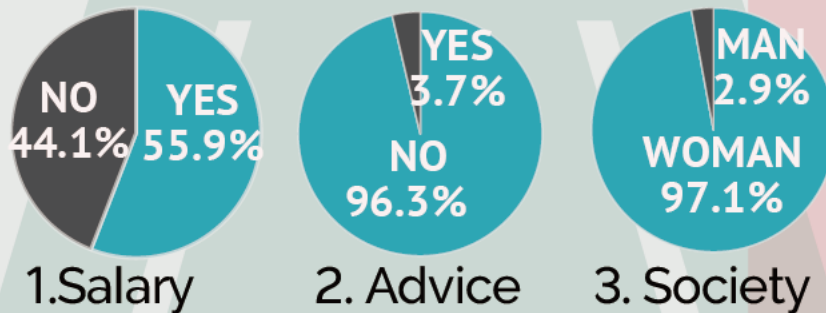


Methodology

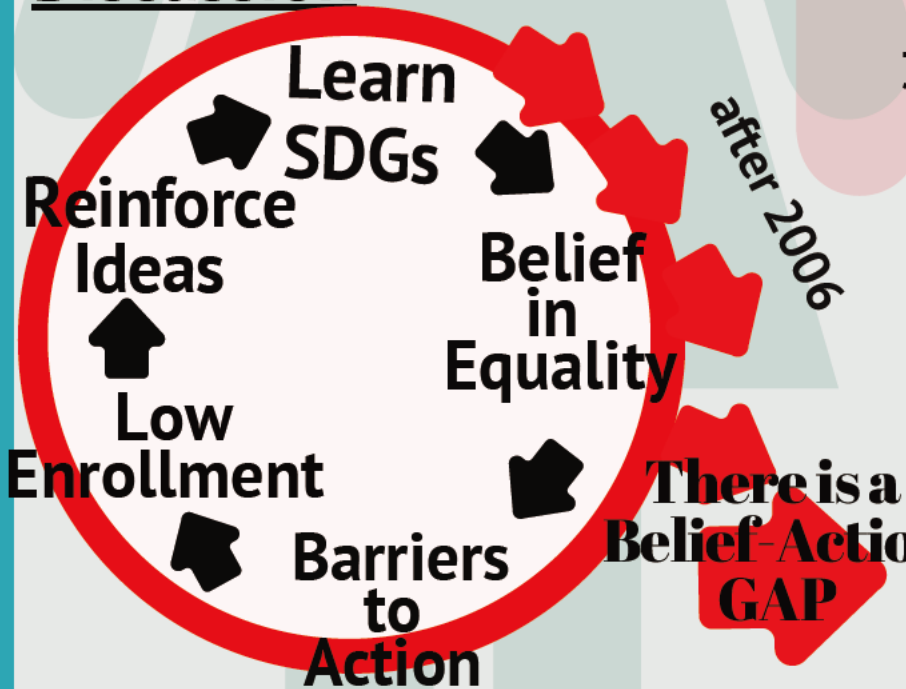
We conducted a survey with **917** students!!
