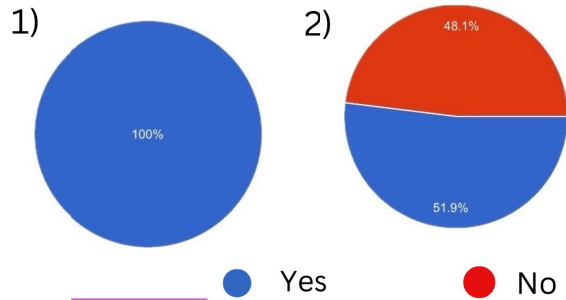
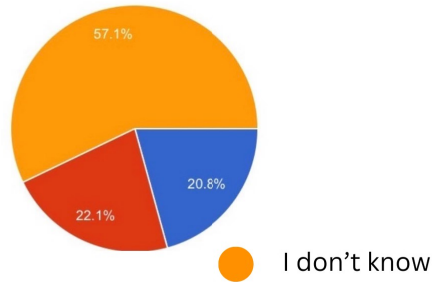


What we can do to aim for a society where we don't feel "difficult to live"

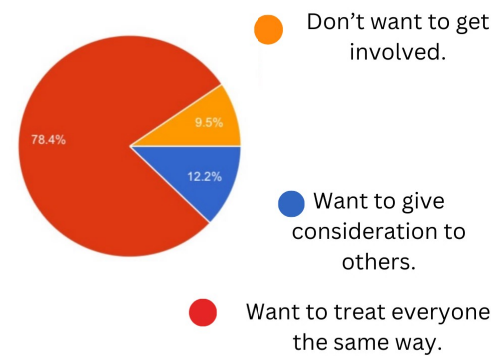
1. Have you ever heard of the word LGBTQ+ ?

[Learning the history of LGBTQ+]

[Training of teachers]
