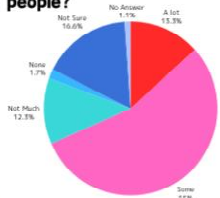

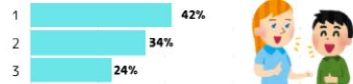
Do you think there is discrimination against foreigners from Japanese people?
