ABSTRACT



BACKGROUND


Cultivated abandoned farmland

The area of abandoned land in 2020 is 244,200 hectares. The rise in abandoned land is often attributed to the aging of and a shortage of famers. Moreover, the number of people who retired farmes and keep having their own land has been increased.



Refugees

The number of people forcibly displaced has reached 100 million as of 2022 because of the Palestinian conflict and the invasion of Ukraine. Although there are refugees who can go home, this is a very rare case. Many developing countries are not actively accepting refugees escaping conflict, so many people are struggling to live their lives.

- ^①Have foreigners be hosted in the farmer's house and having them help with the farming
- They can understand the differences in values that they have and come to accept each other.

②Encourage the farmers who host refugees to interact with other farmers as much as possible so that they can be included in the community

➡If it becomes commonplace to have people from overseas in the community, there will be less resistance to people from overseas.
