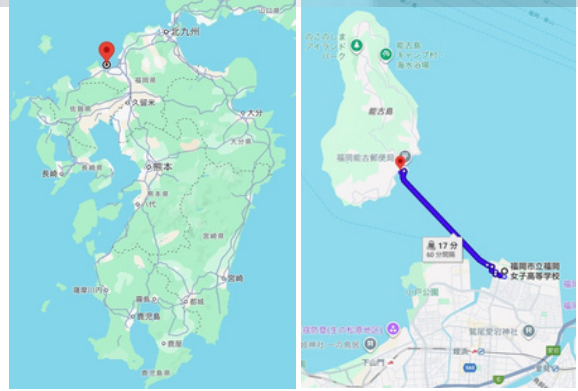


ATTRACTIVENESS OF NOKONOSHIMA FOR THE FUTURE

- About 10 minutes by boat from Noko Ferry Terminal (a relatively easy-to-reach location)
- Collaborating with Fukuoka Girls' High School to create and sell products using Amanatsu oranges
- 200,000 foreign tourists visit annually

BUT

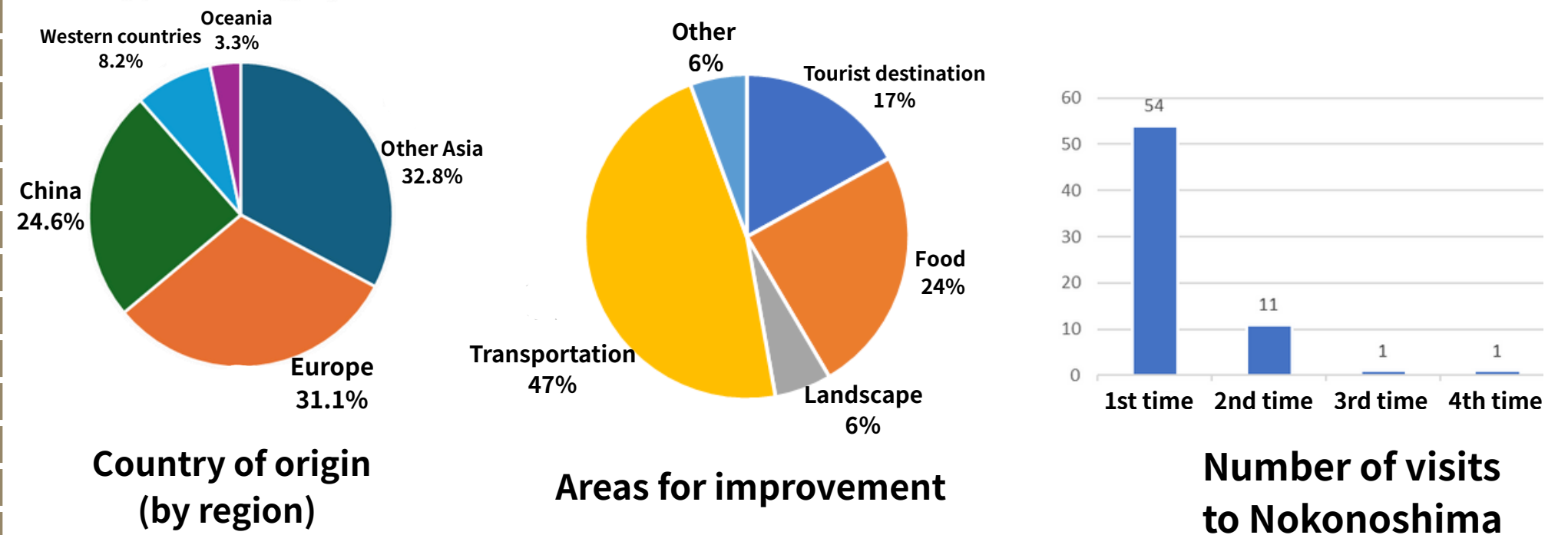
There are many foreign tourists, who want to visit.

- 47% of visitors said getting around island was difficult.
 - Bus stop and ferry information signs are only in Japanese, with no explanations in the other three languages.
 - Chinese visitors said that signs were difficult to understand.
- Post photos of IC cards usable on buses and translate signs.
- When we visited Nokonoshima, we saw foreign tourists who were lost because they didn't know where the bus stops or bike rental places were.



- Make it easier to find bus stops, bicycle rental locations, and tourist attractions.

Purchase souvenirs and charms to remember your trip
- 17:00 — Depart the Island by Ferry

Peak visitation happens during specific seasons.

By making premade schedules, visitors will know when events are happening.

Souvenir Planning to Increase Repeat Visitors

- Currently, the main offerings are food items like jam and jelly made from the island's local specialty Amanatsu oranges.
- We will create characters that gain popularity overseas, like Kumamon from Kumamoto.
- We will produce memorable souvenirs for visiting foreign tourists, such as magnets, clips, T-shirts, and pens featuring the characters.
- The character's theme is "The four seasons of flowers blooming".
- Sell seasonal flower characters as souvenirs, which allows visitors to buy items featuring the flowers they've seen.
- Ensure visitors can find something new each time they shop for souvenirs.
