

35 JP students (2nd to 5th grade)

1. Prep

- ①Get permission
- ②Gather students
- ③Explanatory Meeting
- Select 3-4 tutors per exchange student

①Before school starts

Welcome exchange students

-Self introduction & exchanged contact information



②First Day of school

-Self introduction in each class

-Explain class schedule

Benefits for exchange students

Reduce the anxiety

I can imagine they would feel very anxious and overwhelmed. Do I get to make friends at school? Will the classes be hard? While getting hit with anxiety, this support by students would be a great relief for them.

They were super fun and creative. I learned many new things and met new people. It was the best experience of my life.




Benefits for JP students

3. Daily Support

Future View

New problems	Solutions
Difficult to support during class: Balance of support and own study	Explanations in easy Japanese when exchange students ask. Prepare the English version of printout.
Fewer opportunities to communicate with non-tutor students	Tutors try to help exchange students and other classmates talk to each other. Change tutors regularly.
Lack of care and support for tutor students	Holding a meeting only for tutors once a month where they can share issues and advise to each other.
