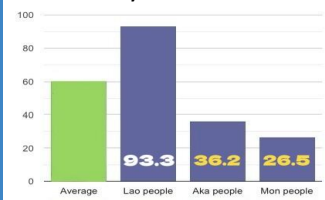

Current situation in Laos

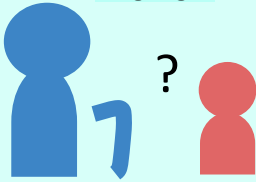
- The Constitution of Laos provides that the official language is Lao

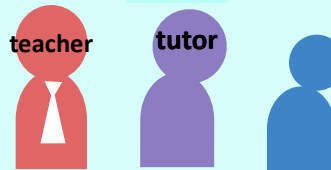

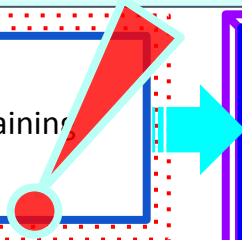

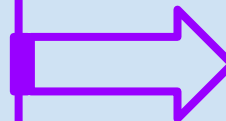
We thought Cyclical Bilingual Training System was good, but we found that children from ethnic minorities cannot enter the cycle because of a lack of money.
