





① Have you participated in a open house?

### Our Focus on Malaysia

#### Language

Providing Japanese traditional food as well as gaining knowledge on religious systems like Halal.



#### Japanese Rules

Informing foreigners especially those who are tourists, Japanese traffic signs and learn about rules from different countries.
