



# BRIDGING THE EDUCATIONAL GAP BETWEEN JAPAN AND CAMBODIA

We created and shared easy-to-understand first aid videos, and Cambodian students enjoyed them.


## 5 [Outlook]

It is difficult to resolve educational disparities through our own efforts alone. Therefore, we believe that many people should be aware of the following three points.


- ① Knowing the facts and taking an interest

Q: What number should they call to call an ambulance?




answer :  n=203


- Elementary school : Some 2th and 4th graders got it wrong, but most students, and 6th graders answered correctly
- High school : Almost everyone got it correct

answer :  n=182

- Generally correct answers for areas that students have studied
- Significantly lower correct answers for areas that students have not studied
