3. Result and Solution

01 There are few trash cans.

⇒ We will make a map showing where trash cans are located.



02 that the subway is very crowded.

⇒ We will create a map of less crowded train routes to tourist spots.

It will also introduce "secret spots" to help spread out tourists.



4. Future prospects

- ① Create maps showing where trash cans are to reduce littering.
- ② Introduce less crowded tourist routes to ease subway congestion.
- ③ Aim to create a town where both tourists and locals can enjoy their time comfortably.



PERIOD POVERTY
