


A better solution for the next pandemic:

No.1 Lock down


New Zealand and Argentina implemented a strict lockdown. However Korea didn't do a lockdown.

No.2 3T


3Ts (Test, Trace, Treat) reduced the number of infection fastest in the world without shutting down. This shows by using 3T, closing the border is more effective than lockdown.



No.3 Financial aid

In Japan, we had a problem with financial aid. For the next pandemic, the government should allocate money to help people who are suffering from severe financial problems.


How People Used the Special Fixed-Sum Cash Benefit (n = 202)
